Aina Haina Facilities Improvement Project Fact Sheet

Background:

- To improve service and reliability, this project will replace aging direct-buried underground cables in the Aina Haina area with new cables in concrete encased conduits.
- The project will also replace several aging electrical transformers with new, upgraded equipment.

Schedule:

- Construction will begin during the week of October 24th and is expected to be completed before the end of 2011, conditions permitting.
- Construction will involve portions of East Hind Drive, Papai Street, Hind Place, and Manauwea Street (see attached map).
- Construction will be scheduled during daylight hours of 8:30 AM to 4:00 PM on weekdays. No holiday or weekend work is planned.
- Work will be done in sections, starting near the intersection with Kalanianaʻole Highway, and moving inward.

Traffic Impact:

- Our contractor (IKAIKA) will allow access by residents to and from their homes as needed.
- Signs, cones and/or flag persons will be used to direct traffic around working areas.
- Street parking in and around the construction area will be restricted during construction work hours, but will be restored at the end of the day.
- Trenched segments will be repaved in accordance with City and County Standards. Quality in compaction shall be tested and monitored to prevent settlement in the repaved areas.

Planned Outages:

- Residents will be notified at least 72 hours in advance, by mail or door-to-door, if planned outages are necessary.
